Dear Parent/Carer,

Temporary home to school transport arrangements for eligible pupils.

The Council is continuing to work with schools and transport operators to ensure children and young people that are entitled to transport can get to school or college if they need to. It is very important that transport is only used for those children and young people that really need it. We are asking that all parents and carers transport their children to school unless they have no other option. If at all possible please keep children at home.

If your child no longer needs transport because you are able to take them to school or college please email TSG@lincolnshire.gov.uk.

If it is essential that your child attends school or college at this time and you cannot transport them then you must contact the Council via email (TSG@lincolnshire.gov.uk) or telephone (01522 782020) as soon as possible.

Please use the same contact details if your child changes their attendance in the future and therefore needs different transport arrangements.

If any new children start to attend schools or colleges then providers, parents and carers must contact the Council as above. Please note it may take up to five days for transport arrangements to be made.

We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding in these challenging times. If it is essential that your child attends school or college at this time and you cannot transport them then you must contact the Council via email (TSG@lincolnshire.gov.uk) or telephone (01522 782020) as soon as possible.
