Tolerance of Different Faiths and Beliefs

Core Concept:

- Learning about different faiths and cultures
- Listen to other viewpoints
- Learning about diversity

Tolerance of Different Faiths and Beliefs in DT:

- In Design and Technology we have a responsibility as designers to not exclude minority groups and to make sure what we design is inline with other faiths and beliefs
- While designing a product it may be important to consider certain factors such as the shape, colour, material or symbols that may be synonymous with other beliefs and how these could be interpreted by different faiths and beliefs

The Rule of Law

Core Concept:

Understanding rules and why they are important Following rules to develop order

The Rule of Law in DT:

- In Design and Technology laws are in place to maintain safety and to prevent inadequate practices
- Laws such as the Health and Safety at Work Act (HASAWA) sets fundamental structure to provide workplace health, safety and welfare
- The Waste Electrical and Electrical Equipment Recycling (WEEE) regulations minimise the impact of electrical equipment on the environment at the end of a products' lifespan and encourages
 - the collection, treatment, recycling and recovery of waste electronic equipment

Democracy

Core Concept:

- Making decisions together
- The right to an opinion/voice

Democracy in DT:

- In Design and Technology a democratic society is important to allow for decisions to be made together and prevent bias
- When working with a client it is important to consider other views and opinions. It is also important to understand that sometimes compromises may need to be made to satisfy both parties
