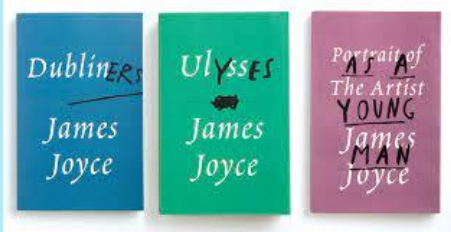


# Who am I?
